### **LEADERSHIP GOALS:**

All three (3) districts have submitted their 2020-2021 leadership goals to Lions Clubs International. The GLT team will work closely with the DG teams of each district to be able to reach and complete those goals.

### **DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS:**

#### **Regional Lions Leadership Institute (RLLI)**

The purpose of this institute planning guide is to provide the necessary information, tools and resources to facilitate an effective Regional Lions Leadership Institute (RLLI). This institute will prepare Lions for leadership positions at all levels. The suggested audience are members ready to pursue leadership roles within their Lions communities. Club leaders would benefit from attending and familiarizing themselves with leadership skills and a deeper understanding of how to better serve clubs.

At this time, MD-16 did not apply to offer an RLLI.

#### **Emerging Lions Leadership Institute (ELLI):**

- Since the ELLI are no longer hosted by LCI, Multiple Districts can apply for a grant for up to \$4,500. MD-16 will not be hosting an ELLI, but is looking for other MDs in order to provide the training to our Lions.

#### **Advanced Lions Leadership Institute (ALLI):**

Advanced Lions Leadership Institutes focus on building the skills of Lions leaders to prepare them for leadership responsibilities at zone, region and district levels. Qualified candidates are Lions that have completed a successful term as club president, but have not yet attained the position of First Vice District Governor.

### **Faculty Development Institute (FDI):**

The Faculty Development Institute program is dedicated to the development and expansion of Lions faculty. The curriculum focuses on techniques and concepts that will enhance the quality of training and overall effectiveness of Lions leadership development programs. Qualified candidates are those Lions who have some experience as faculty members at Lions training events, have demonstrated basic instructional skills, and have a keen interest in further developing those skills. Lions with extensive experience as Lions faculty or as professional trainers are not recommended for this institute but are welcome to apply. Participation is limited to Lions from the Constitutional area noted in the schedule below.

### **Lions Certified Instructor Program (LCIP):**

The Lions Certified Instructor Program (LCIP) training serves as the path by which Lions can apply to become certified instructors. Lions who are LCIP certified are eligible to serve as faculty at locally approved institutes (ELLI, ALLI and FDI), Lions Clubs International-directed institutes\*, the International FVDG/DGE Seminar, and other training-related events. Effective July 2020, LCIP certification is a requirement to serve as Lions Clubs International-directed institutes faculty and FVDG/DGE Seminar Group Leader.

**DISTRICT 16-N GLT REPORT – PDG BRAD DAY, DISTRICT 16-N GLT COORDINATOR:****DISTRICT 16N QUARTERLY REPORT**

The undersigned GLT, in conjunction with the other members of the 16N GAT, GMT Coordinator Lou Lambe and GST Coordinator Nick Landy, has organized and presented monthly training sessions for District 16N Lions. These sessions have been held virtually via Zoom and have been generally well-attended, with approximately 20 attendees at each session.

The goal, from a leadership perspective, has been to conduct trainings for Zone Chairs, and separately, for Club Officers. Following the initial Zone Chair training held in late January, the GAT announced its plan to conduct sequential monthly trainings on the fourth Thursday of February, March, April and possibly May. Using the theme, “The 16N Vaccine...Answers to Your Club’s Virus”, the GAT met via Zoom on a weekly basis to prepare for and conduct the second of these sessions on February 25, 2021 which focused on Club President and First Vice-President training.

A third session is scheduled for March 25, 2021 which will target training for Club Secretaries and Treasurers. The April session promises to address club membership and service issues.

The 16N GAT had applied for and been awarded an LCI grant for reimbursement of training-associated costs incurred. The GAT has submitted the appropriate reports to LCI for reimbursement of the sum of \$159.00, a cost which the District had advanced for enhanced Zoom features. As of this writing, payment has not yet been received.

To date, there continues to be no response from any of the Club Vice-Presidents who had been contacted to request the names of prospective candidates for ALLI and ELLI Leadership conferences. A follow-up communication will be made.


